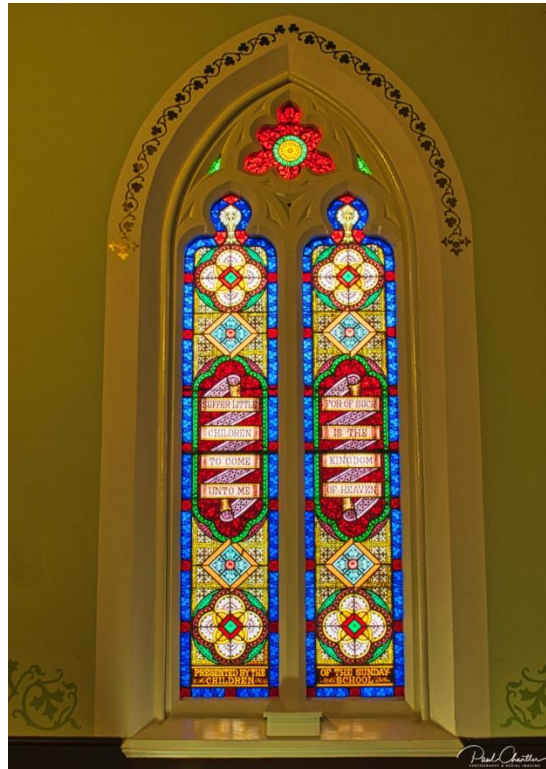

Offering envelopes for 2021 have arrived and will be distributed to users as soon as possible. In order to avoid waste, these new envelopes are not pre-stamped with specific dates and the donor's identification number, so users should make sure that their name and/or donor number is clearly written on the envelope before it is submitted. **During the Covid-19 lock-down, parishioners and friends are asked to make their donations by mail (cheques only please) to our correct postal address (Saint Thomas' Anglican Church, P. O. Box 187, Millbrook, ON, L0A 1G0), or via one of the other methods described at the end of this newsletter.**

The Annual Meeting of Vestry will take place in late February or early March (exact date still to be determined--but most likely a week night). Given the present pandemic, it will be necessary to meet via the Zoom video-conferencing online platform (with telephone connexion available--unfortunately, via a Toronto number which will incur long-distance charges--for those without full computer access). Diocesan canon law does not set a minimum number of people which constitutes a "quorum" for vestry meetings. However, we hope as many people as possible will be able to participate in some way or other. Reports (including the 2021 proposed parish budget) will be sent out electronically (or hand-delivered to those on the Vestry list without email) at least two weeks in advance of the meeting. Any questions/concerns should be directed to the Priest-in-Charge who will forward those questions to the appropriate person for a response. **Written reports from parish organizations should be submitted as soon as possible by email (Word document attachments only please) to the Priest-in-Charge at: nate@nexicom.net.**

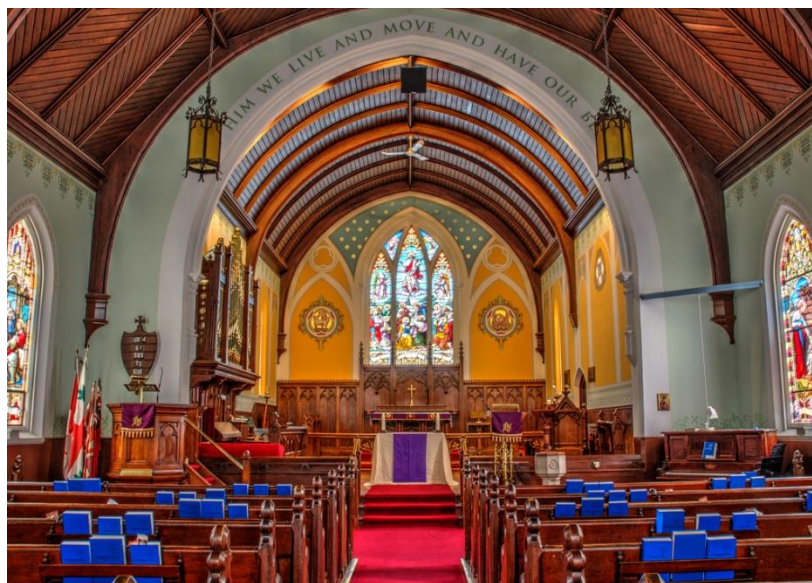

- ***By pre-arranged 'drop off' at the home of the Priest-in-Charge.*** Please call 705-932-1231 to arrange a mutually convenient time.
- ***By pre-arranged 'pick-up' from your home*** - please call 705-932-1231 to arrange a mutually convenient time. All public health protocols ('physical distancing,' etc) will be strictly followed.
- ***By using the outside letter box next to the rear entrance of the parish hall.*** Please ***never leave cash*** in this letter box and also please ***call the priest-in-charge to let him know you have left an envelope in the box so that he may collect it.***
- ***By Pre-Authorized Remittance:*** If you wish to enroll in PAR, please call the parish office during office hours. An authorization form will be mailed (or emailed) to you.
