

As announced last month, a very brief (i.e., 3 minute) <u>special Vestry</u> meeting will take place immediately before the regular <u>Advisory Board</u> meeting after the soup and sandwich lunch on Sunday, February 4<sup>th</sup>. The purpose of this special Vestry is simply to approve the churchwardens' appointment of a new auditor. The Advisory Board which will follow has only one agenda item: a pre-Vestry presentation of the churchwardens' proposed parish budget for 2024.
