



The Millbrook Cenotaph ceremonies will take place the next day on Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 10.45 am, "lest we forget."

The season of Advent begins on Sunday, December 1<sup>st</sup>. In order to celebrate this season more meaningfully, each of us has been invited to join parishioners from St Paul's, Perrytown, in reading a short book "Advent & Christmas: Wisdom from Henri J. M. Nouwen." Each day of the season has a short meditation by Nouwen, a short scripture passage, a prayer, and a suggested action. Please be sure your name and/or envelope number (if you know it) is written on the envelope. If you need offering envelopes, just ask!
- By <u>regular mail</u> addressed to St Thomas' Anglican Church, P. O. Box 187, Millbrook, Ontario, LOA 1GO. Please be sure to include the <u>Post Office Box number</u> on the envelope - not just the street address - when sending items by mail.

Cheques only please - made out to St Thomas' Church. Post-dated cheques, for future contribution periods, would be welcome and very much appreciated.

- By <u>e-transfer</u> from your bank account. Please call Gail Neiman during parish office hours (705-932-2233) or email her at <u>cavmanparish@nexicom.net</u> to arrange this. It is quick and easy to do!
- By <u>Pre-Authorized Remittance from your bank account or credit card.</u> If you wish to
  enroll in PAR, please call the parish office during office hours. An authorization form
  will be mailed (or emailed) to you. If you are already on PAR, you are encouraged to
  re-visit your pledged amount on an annual basis and prayerfully reflect on your
  financial offering to the church.
